Credit unions have long-supported young members as they navigate the college journey and seek to realize their financial goals.

Hundreds of college-bound credit union members have received critical monetary assistance through the New York Credit Union Association's acclaimed Scholarship Program.

As a member of the Association, your credit union can offer this scholarship to your members by submitting this registration form and paying a nominal registration fee based on asset size:

Statewide Program Registration	Fee
Less than \$20 million in assets	\$100
\$20 – \$100 million in assets	\$200
More than \$100 million in assets	\$300

Offering your own credit union scholarship

In addition to participating in the statewide Scholarship Program, you can fund your own credit union scholarships. For a minimal fee (in addition to the registration fee), the Association will provide you with a list of the top 10 applicants from your credit union. The fee for this service is based on credit union asset size.

Offering a chapter scholarship

Chapter scholarships are an excellent complement to the statewide Scholarship Program. For a fee of \$150, chapters can obtain the names of the top 10 scorers from participating credit unions. Registration forms have been sent to your chapter president, so contact him/her to learn more.

If you would like to receive more than your top 10 scores, you can make that request when sending your credit union's/chapter's completed applications to the Association. The cost for additional scores is \$3.00 per score, which will be billed upon receipt of the request.

Registration

To participate in the 2019 Scholarship Program, complete the attached registration form and return it, with your share draft/check, no later than **Friday, October 12, 2018**. Your promotional materials will be sent to the email address and mailing address listed on your registration form.

Promotional resources

The Association provides participating credit unions with materials to promote the Scholarship Program and maximize participation. Materials are available free of charge and include:

- an electronic scholarship application master that can be duplicated;
- two 12 x 18 posters, 22 x 28 PDF of poster;
- a print-quality PDF flyer for distribution;
- a sample newsletter article;
- a sample news release;
- a sample letter to send to sponsor groups/schools encouraging their participation; and
- a list of ideas to ensure program success.

Scholarship funding

Multiple scholarships will be awarded. Because the program is self-funded, the number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the amount of money raised through credit union registration fees. In 2018, the Association awarded three \$1,500, twelve \$1,000 and twelve \$750 scholarships.

Application process

Eligible students (see requirements in following section) must submit their completed scholarship applications directly to your credit union. You should then forward all applications to the Association by Friday, January 18, 2019. Participating credit unions/chapters will be notified of the scholarship winners in early May.

Eligibility requirements

Applicants must be high school seniors who:

- will be attending college for the first time in the fall of 2019
- will be enrolled in either a two or four-year college; and
- are a member of a participating credit union
